Exterior	CR-V offers a panoramic moonroof, starting on the Touring trim	RAV4 does not offer a panoramic moonroof on any gas-powered or Hybrid trim

	CR-V delivers excellent fuel economy without a big upcharge	Due to a higher MSRP, the Hybrid's fuel savings can take up to 5 years of ownership to be realized. Many RAV4 Hybrid lessees will not see any savings during their lease term.

	Rear doors offer an 85-degree opening angle for easier entry/exit and less restrictive access to the 2nd row	RAV4's rear doors offer a noticeably narrower opening angle compared to CR-V
	Standard factory-installed remote engine start	Does not offer factory-installed remote engine start
	Capless fueling system comes standard	Conventional screw-cap fueling system
	Cargo-area seat-release levers provide convenient, one-handed seat-folding operation	Rear seatback-mounted release levers require more effort and time to operate than CR-V's
